SUMMARY:

Officers responded to a possible kidnapping from the City of Beloit where the victim had been released in the City of Janesville. Upon speaking with the alleged victim we were unable to verify the story and eventually were able to find out that the entire incident was fabricated. No arrest made.

INITIAL CALL RESPONSE:

Officers responded to a possible kidnapping where the victim was currently on a phone located at Stop n Go 714 Center Avenue. The notes indicated that the victim had been abducted in the City of Beloit near Beloit College driven to Janesville where he was able to get out of the vehicle at the Stop n Go.

Upon arrival on scene Officer Schoonover and I began speaking with the victim Michael Key to get a description of the vehicle and suspect. While other officers were responding to the area Key's statement to us became very suspicious and at one point when Key was speaking with me Officer Schoonover requested and asked if he could look at Key's phone. Key allowed Officer Schoonover to access his phone while I was still speaking with him.

Several minutes later Officer Schoonover asked Key if he wanted to be honest with us now about the incident. Key tried to act like he didn't know what he was being asked. Officer Schoonover read Key all the text messages from a "Tony" subject verifying that Key had asked Tony to pick him up at Beloit College, offered to pay for gas to come pick him up and that they were going to hang out for the night. Once Key was confronted with this information he eventually gave the actual version of what happened.

Key indicates that he just registered for Beloit College and is from Arkansas and has only been up here for a couple weeks. Key admitted that he went on the Grinder app and located a subject asking him to hang out. They had text messages back and forth where they made arrangements for the Tony subject to pick him up at Beloit College and bring him to Janesville for a party to hang out. Key indicates that when he was brought back to Janesville he doesn't know exactly where he was but that he did not like the aviance of the party indicating that there was drinking and smoking which he does not approve of. Key had asked Tony to take him back to Beloit where Tony became upset indicating that he just got to the party and was not going to be driving him back to Beloit. Key eventually was able to talk Tony into getting back in the vehicle and when they began driving away Tony pulled into the gas station and told Key

to get out. Key indicated that he does not know where he is at or how to get back to Beloit College and was scared.

We were unable to identify any other information from Tony as there was only a phone number. Through back trace that phone number has no prior contacts and upon calling it there was no answer. We gave Key a life lesson in not going on suspicious apps and making arrangements with strangers in a city he did not know and also gave him directions to go back to Beloit College. We advised Key on filing false police reports and the consequences in the future.

NO FOLLOW-UP:

No follow-up is recommended in this manner since the initial report was false and everybody was OK.
